







THIS TRUST DEED made on the 22nd day of Dec. 1994 by Lala Sher Singh Memorial Jeevan Vigyan Trust K-1, Green Park Main New Delhi (hereinafter referred to as the trust) on one part

and

- (1) Mr. Suresh Chand Jain S/o Sh. Sher Singh aged 54 years r/o D- 35 Panchsheel Enclave, New Delhi.
- (2) Mr. Naresh Chand Jain s/o Sh. Sher Singh aged 52 years r/o D-35 Panchsheel Enclave, New Delhi.
- (3) Mr. Ramesh Chand Jain S/o Sh. Sher Singh aged 44 years r/o D-35 Panchsheel Enclave, New Delhi.
- (4) Mr. Rajesh Jain S/o H.C. Jain aged 26 years r/o D-35, Panchsheel Enclave New Delhi.
- (5) Mr. Lalit Jain s/o Sh. H.C. Jain aged 24 years r/o D-35, Panchsheel Enclave New Delhi.
- (6) Mr. Mani Jain s/o Sh. H.C. Jain aged 22 years r/o D-35, Panchsheel Enclave New Delhi.

hereinafter called the Founder Trustees (which expression shall unless excluded by or repugnant to the context to be deemed to include their successor or successors and the trustee for the time being to these presents and their survivor or survivors) at the other part.

AND WHEREAS under the Lala Sher Singh Memorial Jeevan Vigyan Trust Rules, the custody, control and management of the Fund shall be vested in the duly constituted Board of Trustees;

b) to establish progressive institutions or other educational institutions in Delhi or outside Delhi, open to all with out any distinction of race or creed or caste or special status with a view:-


- (i) to impart sound and liberal education/training to boys and girls during their impressionable years a type of education/training that will lay stress on character building, team work, aspirated corps, physical development and will infuse in institution children a spirit of adventure, fair play and justice.
- (ii) to develop among its students a feeling of pride in Indian culture and to produce citizens who will be truly Indian and will rise above social, communal, religious or provincial prejudices.

2. In furtherance of these objects, it shall

- a) construct, demolish or alter any buildings which may be necessary or convenient for its objects;
- b) provide hostels and residence, as may be needed, for such students, teachers, and workers who belong to or work for it;
- c) sell, lease, mortgage, charge, surrender let on hire, exchange, dispose of, or otherwise transfer for consideration or by way of gift all or any portion of its property, rights, assets, any liabilities to any other Trust, person or persons;
- d) purchase, take on lease, or exchange, hire, accept as a gift or otherwise acquire or deal in any movable or movable property, or rights thereto, attaching which may be necessary or convenient for its objects;
- e) buy, sell, endorse, negotiate or transfer all Government or other securities and to collect and realise interest, bonus, dividend or profits on such securities;
- f) invest and deal with its funds and moneys in securities or property and to operate its accounts with any bank, bankers or shroffs, etc. upon such terms and conditions and in such manner as may from time to time be determined or deemed expedient;
- g) lend or otherwise employ moneys belonging to it, to borrow or raise money with or without security by mortgaging or debenture or charging the whole or any part of its property, assets or rights and on such

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terms and conditions, as may be determined from time to time;

h) do all such other acts and things whether incidental to the powers aforesaid or not, as may be requisite in order to further its objects;

i) engage, invest or enter into any contractual obligations for the purpose of promotion of sound and liberal education/training;

j) take over, on such terms as may be determined, any existing institution or educational institution with its properties, movable and with or without its liabilities and to carry on the same as an educational institution or to amalgamate the same with any institution established by the Trust and to amalgamate with any other Trust having similar objects;

k) enter into any arrangement with Government for securing grants in aid of any institution belonging to the Trust;

l) provide on welfare and on humanitarian grounds all necessary facilities for the benefit of all the educational institutions of the Trust;

## II. Membership:

1) For the purpose of registration the Trust is declared to consist of 6 members but it may, when it thinks fit, increase the number of members.

2) i) There may be a President and a Vice-President of the Trust who will be ipso facto members of the Trust and the Working Committee and would be invited to attend all meetings of these bodies.


ii) The Trust will elect its Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Hon. Treasurer and three other members to serve on the Working Committee of the institution.

3) The Chairman in consultation with the Working Committee may from time to time determine the terms and conditions on which any other persons shall be admitted to the membership of the Trust and it shall rest with the Trust whether any person shall or shall not be admitted to membership.

4) Any person in sympathy with the objects of the Trust shall be eligible to become a member of the Trust.

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5) After the Chairman approves of the proposal made by any member of the Trust for enlisting a member, his election to membership of the Trust could take place by circulation among members of the Trust.

6) The Chairman of the Trust may in consultation with President and Vice-President or in consultation with the Working Committee at any time by notice in writing require a member to withdraw from the Trust and the person so required to withdraw shall, at the expiration of one month from such notices being given, cease to be a member.

7) Resignation from membership shall be tendered to the Chairman of the Trust by registered post and it shall take effect forthwith.

8) Every person shall, on becoming a member of the Trust sign the Roll of Members of the Trust to be kept in a bound register.


9) The quorum for holding a meeting of the Trust shall be two members. No. quorum shall be required in the case of adjourned meetings.

10) The members of the Trust shall meet at least once in a calendar year. It shall be necessary to give at least twenty one days notice for calling the annual meeting of the trust. In Annual Meeting Budget of the Trust shall be passed and election of the Working Committee, Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Treasurer and Secretary, if any, shall be held. Other meetings may be called by the Chairman at ten days notice or at a shorter notice.

11) Every member of the Trust undertakes to contribute to the Assets of the Trust, in the event of the same being woundup during the time that he is a member, or within one year afterward, for payment of the costs, charges and expenses of winding up the same, such amount as may be required not exceeding Rs. 100/- (Rupees one hundred).

12) If upon the winding up or dissolution of the Trust there remains, after satisfaction of all its debts and liabilities any property whatsoever, the same shall not be paid to or distributed among the members of the Trust, but shall be given or transferred to some other institutions or institution having objects similar to the objects of the Trust, and which shall prohibit the distribution of its or their income and property among its or their members at or before the time of dissolution and if and so far as effect cannot be given to the aforesaid provision then the same charitable object.

III

Voting:

Unless otherwise provided by the bye-laws, all disputed questions at meetings shall be determined by vote. Each member of the Trust or of the Working Committee as the case may be, present at the meeting shall have one vote and the votes of the majority shall prevail. In case of equality of votes, the Chairman shall have a casting vote.

IV

Amendment of the Memorandum

In case it is deemed expedient to alter, extend or abridge the purpose for which the Trust is constituted or to amalgamate it either wholly or partly with any other Trust or body having similar purpose, the same shall be done in accordance with the provision of section 12 of the Societies Registration Act 1860.

V

Movable and Immovable Property

All deeds of transfer, lease and other documents relating to the movable and immovable property of the Trust shall be signed by the Chairman and the Treasurer or Secretary of the Trust under authority from the Board of Trustees. All documents and records of the Trust shall be maintained at the premises of the Trust and or at such other place for safe custody as the Trust may determine by separate resolution.

VI.

Amendment of the Rules and Regulations

The Rules and Regulations of the Trust may be altered varied or revoked at any time by a resolution passed by a majority of the members of the Trust present at any meeting of the Trust which shall have been convened for that purpose. For the amendment of the memorandum of the Association para IV will hold good.

VII. All provisions of the Societies Registration Act 1860 shall apply to Lala Sher Singh Smiriti Jivan Vigyan Sangathan.

VIII.


Working Committee

1. The general management of the affairs of the Trust shall be vested in and rest with the Working Committee who for the purpose of the Societies Registration Act 1860 shall be taken to be and shall act as the Governing Body of the Trust.

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2. The Working Committee shall consist of (1) Chairman, (2) Vice-Chairman (3) Treasurer (4) Secretary (5) Two other persons elected by the Trust from among its own members.

One of the two elected members or any other suitable person could be appointed as Education Member. If such a person is not a member of the Working Committee, he would become an ex-officio member of the Working Committee and of the Trust.

3. The members of the Working Committee shall be eligible for reselection.

4. A member of Working Committee shall hold office for 3 years. The teacher member shall hold office for one year.

5. (a) The working committee shall meet ordinarily once in two months. The quorum of the meetings shall be two.

(b) In case the quorum is not complete the meeting shall be adjourned and fixed for any day, seven days after the said meeting. Notice of an adjourned meeting shall be sent to the members under Certificate of Posting. If again on the day fixed for the adjourned meeting the quorum is not complete, the members present shall proceed to dispose of the business, as if the required quorum was complete.


(c) In case of an emergency the Secretary may with the approval of the Chairman of the Working Committee call a meeting at 2 days' notice.

6. The Secretary shall ordinarily give seven days notice for the meetings.

7. The decision of the Working Committee may in case of urgency, with the approval of the Chairman, be arrived at by circulation of the proposal and getting assent of the members of the Working Committee present at the time in Delhi.

8. The working Committee shall do all such things as they consider necessary or expedient for the purpose of carrying out the objects of the Trust.

9. All acts done at any meeting of the Working Committee or by any person as a member of the Working Committee shall be laid notwithstanding that it be afterwards discovered that there was some disqualification or defect in the appointment of any member of the Working Committee.



10. No act of the proceedings of the Working Committee shall be invalid merely by reason of the existence of a vacancy or vacancies in the body or any defect in the co-option, nomination or election of any of its members.

11. No members of the Working Committee shall be personally or individually answerable for any loss arising in the administration or application of the funds of the institution for any damage to or deterioration that shall not happen by or through his or their willful default or neglect.

12. The Working Committee may enter into any agreement with the Government regarding grants in aid for any institution belonging to the Trust whether the grant is recurring or a capital grant.

President and Vice President

IX.

1. The Trust may elect a President and Vice-President of the following categories : -

(a) They may be elected among the members of the Trust who have eminent record of public service particularly in the field of training and have rendered long and distinguished service for a number of years as members of the Working Committee and/or as Chairman of the Trust.

OR


(b) From among persons of such eminence in public life that their association with the Trust will add luster to its activities and will provide guidance and inspiration for its working.

2. The President and Vice-President will be invited to all meetings of the Trust and the Working Committee and their advice sought on all vital policy matters connected with the running of the institutions under the Trust.

Chairman

The Trust shall elect from among its own members a Chairman to hold office for three years. He shall be eligible for re-election.

In any emergency which, in the opinion of the Chairman requires that immediate action should be taken, the



Chairman shall take such action as he thinks necessary and shall, at the earliest opportunity thereafter, report his action to the Working Committee.

XI. Member Incharge Education and Training

The Working Committee shall nominate a distinguished educationist as Member Incharge Education and training. Such a person will keep close contact with head of the institutions and other heads of the Institution under the Trust to ensure that the standard of education/training is maintained and continuously improved.

XII. VICE-CHAIRMAN

The trust shall elect from its own members a Vice-Chairman to hold office for three years. He shall be eligible for re-election.

He shall perform the duties of the Chairman when the latter is absent from meetings. He shall also function as Chairman when the latter is unable for any reason to perform the duties of his office.

XIII. Secretary


1. The Trust may appoint one of its Members or any other person as a Secretary on such terms and conditions as it may consider suitable.

2. He shall convene meeting of the Trust and its Working Committee, shall circulate agenda and maintain records of the proceeding of these meetings. He shall see that the decisions of the Trust and the Working Committee are implemented and shall make a report to this effect at the next meeting of the Trust or the Working Committee, as the case may be.

3. He shall be responsible for the maintenance of the documents of the trust.

4. He shall exercise such other powers and perform such other duties as may be imposed by the Rules and Regulations or as the Trust may from time to time determine by resolutions.

5. The Trust may sue or be sued in the name of the Secretary who will be competent to employ Lawyers and attorneys for the purpose of prosecution and defense of suits and legal proceedings and to sign plaints, written statements, Vakalatnamas, affidavits and other papers in relation thereto as well as file or receive back documents, and moneys belonging to or meant for



the Trust.

6. He shall be responsible for co-ordinating the activities of the different institutions under the control of the Trust.

7. Subject to the powers and functions of the Treasurer, as defined above, he shall satisfy himself that all moneys are expended for the purpose for which they are granted, sanctioned or allotted.

XIV.

#### The Board of Trustees

All immovable property of the institution be vested in a Board of Trustees consisting of the members of the Trust selected by the Trust and they will not be entitled to alienate or encumber it in any manner without a decision of the Working Committee. The Trustees so selected shall hold office for such period as the Trust may determine.

XV.

#### Finance and Accounts

1. The account of the Trust and the institutions shall be kept in the form and on the lines laid down by the Working Committee and shall be audited periodically by a firm of Chartered Accountants appointed by the Trust.

2. All moneys received for and on behalf of the institution shall be paid into the appropriate account in the Bank/Banks approved by the Working Committee.

3. Except for small bills amounting to less than Rs.50/- all payments would be made by cheques and proper receipts taken.


4. The annual accounts and balance sheet of the Trust as also of the institutions, as prepared by the institution auditors, along with audit report shall be submitted to the Finance and Working Committee of the institution.

5. The funds of the Trust shall be employed solely for the purpose and objects of the Trust.

6. Moneys accruing specially to or in respect of the institution fund of each recognized institution belonging to the Trust and money made available from the funds of the financing of any such institutions shall be deposited and withdrawn in accordance with rules framed under Delhi Education Act 1973.
